

Youth Experiential Training Institute (Y.E.T.I.)

Program Coordinator - School Year

About:

Y.E.T.I. provides access to outdoor recreation for youth in King County by mitigating financial, gender, and cultural barriers. Our programs foster a sense of belonging that develops the skills, confidence, and curiosity to thrive in the outdoors and in everyday life.

Description:

Y.E.T.I. is based in Normandy Park, WA, and mainly works with students in the Highline and Tukwila School District. The Program Coordinator works alongside community partners, volunteers, and other staff to facilitate outdoor experiences for young people. Strong candidates will have experience in youth-based outdoor programs, work in public schools, and a passion for connecting young people to the natural world. Candidates will have the ability to build and maintain emotionally safe learning environments and experience working with diverse student groups. Regularly they will employ instructional skills, problem solving and judgment and decision making to implement programs.

Compensation This position is an hourly with a pay range of \$20-\$30/hour depending on experience.

Schedule: The Schedule varies based on the student trips that you will help plan and lead. Typically each week you will work 4 weekday afternoons at a school in the 12:00-6:00 pm time frame, one weekend outdoor trip 8:00 am-3:00 pm and remote planning time and project time in between. responsibilities will also include projects such as gear management, communication or other program development.

Hours: Typical week will be 30 hours.

Season: This role starts September and runs 9 months ending in early June.

Required Skills

- Experience delivering youth programs
- Experience working with diverse student populations
- Valid driver's license and willingness to drive 12 passenger van
- CPR and Wilderness First Aid training
- Ability to pass a background check
- Ability and willingness to learn and lead outdoor activity including; kayaking, biking, snowshoeing. hiking, rock climbing and more.

- Create an emotionally safe space for students and volunteers
- Facilitate Student Outdoor Club Meetings
- Build positive relationships with young people
- Transport trailers and equipment
- Support other instructional staff
- Support sound risk management
- Other duties as needed
