### **About:**

Y.E.T.I. provides access to outdoor recreation for youth in King County by mitigating financial, gender, and cultural barriers. Our programs foster a sense of belonging that develops the skills, confidence, and curiosity to thrive in the outdoors and in everyday life.

### **Description:**

Y.E.T.I. is based in Normandy Park, WA, and mainly works with students in the Highline School District (Des Moines, Burien, SeaTac). Field Instructors for our programs work alongside community partners, volunteers, and other staff to facilitate outdoor experiences for young people. Strong candidates will have experience in youth-based outdoor programs, a passion for connecting young people to the natural world, the ability to build and maintain emotionally safe learning environments, experience working with diverse student groups, sound instructional skills, and a proven record of judgment and decision making.

**Compensation:** \$22-26 per hour depending on experience

**Hours:** 12 hours per week over two weekdays. Opportunities to work more hours may be available during busy times
